CONDUCT

“Die Eiland” is a Christian Centre used primarily for ministry. Right of admission is always reserved.

Our desire is to make your stay with us memorable and positive. For that, we rely on every member of the group. What is good for the individual is also good for the group, and a happy group consists of happy individuals. We therefore kindly request your co-operation to prevent the following:

- Misbehaving or causing damage to any property.
- Causing danger or bodily harm to anyone.
- Contravening the laws of the country in any way.
- Disregarding requests from our staff.
- Inconvenience of any members of the group.

HOUSE RULES

Facilities:

- Please avoid damage to buildings and equipment.
- Help us keep our facilities up to standard by reporting any damage or equipment that is defective as soon as possible.
- No furniture, couches, mattresses, or bedding may be removed from allocated places.
- No ball games or roller skates are allowed inside the building.
- No jumping on beds or climbing on cupboards.
- Do not stick / paste anything to the walls or furniture.
- Mattresses must stay on the beds.
- Please save water and electricity.

Kitchen

At the time of departure:

- Stoves and ovens must be clean, and the gas must be turned off.
- Fridges and freezers must be clean – do not switch off.
- Kitchen equipment needs to be clean and placed back after it has been used.

Bathrooms:

- Use water sparingly, for the benefit of all.
- Leave the bathroom just as neat as you would like to find it.
- Dishes may not be washed in the bathrooms, only in the kitchen and the outside steel basins.

Safety:

- Do not play with fire extinguishers, diffusers or electrical wiring.
- Fires may only be made in dedicated braai areas or braai bins due to the high fire risk area. Never leave any fire unattended and please extinguish any fire after use.
- Water in taps is drinking water.
- No flammable substances, fireworks, or weapons may be stored inside the building.
- Do not leave valuables in front of windows.
- Nothing must be placed in front of the emergency doors or the corridors that lead towards it – due to the evacuation procedure.
- When mopping the floors, use the yellow 'wet floor' indicators to prevent injuries.
- Adventure obstacles may not be used without our qualified supervision.
- **In case of a power outage:** We have an inverter system in place. The gas stove will still work, but will have to be ignited with matches/lighter. Battery-powered LED lights can be provided.

Vehicles

- **Parking:** Vehicles may only park on designated parking areas - not on lawns.
- **Main gate:** Use remote to open / close the gate (it does not work automatically). Otherwise, call the office (069 687 6346).

Recreation:

- Games only take place on the **big lawn**. We only use the Obstacle course for training purposes.
- Swimming in the river is not allowed.

General:

- No alcohol is allowed on the site.
- Cigarette smoking is only allowed outside of the building at the dedicated area. The cigarette buds must be put out and thrown in the bin.
- Silence from 22:00 - 06:00.
- The use of facilities is on own risk. We cannot accept responsibility for damage, theft, lost property, or injuries.
- The kitchen, rooms, bathrooms, hall, and lounge must be clean at the time of departure.
- Keep Campsite litter-free. Rubbish must be put in the provided waste bins.
- All windows and doors must be closed when departing.
